ADDITIONAL CHARGES

+ 50 €	= Parking during pickup/delivery, rate for each started hour
+ 50 €	= Empty driveway due to customer's fault, order cancellation, goods not ready, etc.
+ 95 €	= Hazardous materials (IMO, ADR)
+ 20%	= Temperature controlled transport
+ 6 €	= Delivery or collection to a private person
+ 40 €	= Delivery notification within two hours. If possible.
+ 4 €	= Return of customer documents signed by the recipient.
+ 2.5 €	= Manual entry of a customer order by an HRX employee
+ 4 €	= Manual preparation of a waybill and/or address label
+ 30 €	= Carrier fee. i.e. Pallet, when transport safety requires its replacement
+ 30 €	= Invoice in paper form, sent by post.
+ 20 €	= Delivery fee in special postal codes FI, SE

WEIGHT CALCULATION INFORMATION

1 m³=333 kg
 1 LDM=1850 kg
 Item length from 2.41 to 3.99 m = 2 x own weight, however, not less than 50 kg
 Item length from 4.0 to 5.99 m = 3 x own weight, however, not less than 250 kg
 Item length from 6.0 to 6.99 m = 4 x own weight, however, not less than 740 kg
 Item length from 7.0 to 9.99 m = 5 x own weight, however, not less than 1500 kg
 Item length over 10.0 m = 6 x own weight, however, not less than 1850 kg
 FIN pallet (120*100) counted as 925 kg when higher than 120 cm / 0.5 Ldm
 EUR pallet (120*80) counted as 740 kg when higher than 120 cm / 0.4 Ldm
 Half pallet (80*60) counts as 370 kg when higher than 120 cm / 0.2 Ldm
 Stackable pallet, any dimensions. However, no higher than 120 cm
 IBC container 1000L (120*100) calculated as 925 kg or actual or calculated weight if higher
 IBC container 1000L, (120*100) - Stackable, according to higher actual or volumetric weight

Storage

2 - 5 days = 0,50 € / 100 kg / day
 6 - 15 days = 0,70 € / 100 kg / day
 over 16 days = 1,00 € / 100 kg / day
 The minimum fee is €15

METHOD OF CALCULATION OF CONVERSION WEIGHT

To calculate the weight of a package and/or a pallet, the higher of the actual weight, cubic metre or cargo metre is used.

- The weight per cubic meter is determined by multiplying the maximum dimensions of the shipment (length x width x height).
- The result obtained in this way is multiplied by the adopted m³ coefficient
- The weight of a cargo meter is calculated by multiplying the length and width of the package/pallet and then dividing by 2.4.
- The result obtained in this way is multiplied by the adopted LDM coefficient

The total weight of the shipment is calculated by adding the individual weights of the pallets and/or packages in the shipment.
